
I. Profile management – administrator overview (1/3)

Administration The setting is automatic and cannot be set administratively.

For users with the "Show company profile data" permission, this release expands the profile management functionality to include the ability to search for users with administrative privileges.




















I. Profile management – administrator overview (2/3)

It is possible to search for users who have at least one administrative permission, a specific permission, or who belong to a particular user group.



















II. Adjustment of security standard for password policy

Administration The setting is automatic and cannot be set administratively.

To further enhance the system's security standards and meet current PCI DSS requirements, the following changes will take effect with this release:

- If a password is not used for 90 days, it will be removed from the profile. Logging in will then only be possible by requesting a password reset link, which will be sent to the registered email address. Once a new password that meets the minimum requirements is set, login will be possible again.
- After a password is changed, all sessions including the current session will be terminated.
- The new default policy requires passwords to be at least 12 characters long and include at least one digit. Additionally, the last 4 used passwords cannot be reused for at least 12 months.

 Alignment of Custom Settings: Any custom client settings will be elevated to match the current security level.
- A notification email about upcoming password deactivation will be sent 10 days in advance.

If no password has ever been set for a profile (e.g., because login is handled via SSO), this process does not apply.

















III. Extension of XML transaction data export

The onesto transaction data export in XML format has been enhanced to include information on the threshold value of the booked flight or hotel service within the travel policy.

While the booked price has already been part of the export file, the respective threshold value which triggered a yellow or red traffic light status can now also be extracted for further internal processing.

Additionally, any justification entered during the booking process (if required) can now be evaluated as part of the transaction data export.

















IV. Hiding the login screen when using SSO



For customers who have configured Single Sign-On (SSO), it is now possible to activate SSO as the only authentication method. In this case, the username and password fields on the login page will no longer be displayed. Likewise, options to reset or change the password will be removed.

This change does not affect the login process for onesto2go.



















V. Standard reports with travel end date

Administration The setting is automatic and cannot be set administratively.

The standard reports offered in the system (Flight, Train, Rental Car, Hotel, and Overall by Booking or Travel Date) will now include an additional column titled "End date of Travel," alongside the existing booking and departure dates.

















VI. Display of issuing country for passport in profile

Administration The setting is automatic and cannot be set administratively.

Within profile management, in the "Official Documents" section, the issuing country will now be displayed in addition to the labels "Passport" or "Identity Card." This enhancement provides better differentiation, especially for employees with dual citizenship. If the issuing country is "Germany," the familiar symbol remains; for other countries, the respective country flag will be shown.

I. Deutschland-Ticket in the traveller profile for the DB Partner Interface (PST) (1/4)

Administration The setting is automatic and cannot be set administratively.



The Deutschland-Ticket can now be stored in the profile for travellers and will only apply when using the DB partner interface (PST).

It can be selected whether the Deutschland-Ticket should always be considered.

In this case, the Deutschland-Ticket will be automatically applied to every DB booking when using the DB partner interface (PST).




















I. Deutschland-Ticket in the traveller profile for the DB Partner Interface (PST) (2/4)

Administration The setting is automatic and cannot be set administratively.

When booking, the Deutschland-Ticket can be selected or deselected.



The Deutschland-Ticket will be considered during the price query, and no fare will be charged for the regional transport portion of the journey.

However, the Deutschland-Ticket must be carried on the relevant trains for the trip!


















I. Deutschland-Ticket in the traveller profile for the DB Partner Interface (PST) (3/4)

Administration The setting is automatic and cannot be set administratively. ID 13989



During the booking process, on the onesto travel plan, and on the DB ticket itself, a reminder text and a mouseover message will indicate the need for an additional ticket.





















I. Deutschland-Ticket in the traveller profile for the DB Partner Interface (PST) (4/4)

Administration The setting is automatic and cannot be set administratively.



Please also note the regulations of Deutsche Bahn regarding the transport contract and passenger rights:

"When combining both tickets, journeys in regional transport using the Deutschland-Ticket and long-distance travel using the long-distance ticket are each considered separate transport contracts. The right to continuous passenger rights between regional and long-distance transport does not apply.

For example, if a regional train is delayed and the connection to a long-distance train is missed, the train binding will not be lifted, and travel on a later train with a ticket that has a train binding (e.g. saver fares) is not possible. Any passenger rights compensation claims will also be considered separately for the respective long-distance ticket or the Deutschland-Ticket."

Travel in First Class:

The Deutschland-Ticket is only valid for travel in the 2nd class.

If the Deutschland-Ticket is used for first-class travel, the affected regional sections must be travelled in the 2nd class.

If regional trains are also used in first class, a first-class ticket for the entire route must be purchased without considering the Deutschland-Ticket.

















II. bahn.business - SBB (Swiss Federal Railways) can now be booked as a one-way ticket (1/3)

Administration The setting is automatic and cannot be set administratively.



It is now possible to book tickets for the Swiss Federal Railways (SBB) via the bahn.business interface. Both domestic train routes within Switzerland and cross-border routes can be booked.

The query is performed from onesto, with a transition to bahn.business.

- Currently, only one-way tickets for SBB can be booked through bahn.business.
- If a round-trip is queried, bahn.business cannot calculate the fare.
- To book a round-trip, both the outbound and return journeys must be booked separately.
- An extension for round-trip tickets is planned for early 2026.




















II. bahn.business - SBB (Swiss Federal Railways) can now be booked as a one-way ticket (2/3)

Administration The setting is automatic and cannot be set administratively.

- The billing is done in the same way as for a DB booking (e.g. to the company account card).
- The VAT is displayed on the SBB ticket and is not available through AirPlus.
- The ticket is sent as a PDF via email by DB and can also be retrieved from DB using the order number.





















II. bahn.business - SBB (Swiss Federal Railways) can now be booked as a one-way ticket (3/3)

Administration The setting is automatic and cannot be set administratively.

- When booking, the age of the travellers is queried on the DB page.
- This must match the date of birth.
- The booking of SBB tickets cannot be disabled or administrated through onesto.
- Booking is only possible via bahn.business, not via the DB partner interface (PST).
- Corporate discounts negotiated with SBB do not apply when booking SBB tickets through bahn.business. Only public fares can be booked. Discount cards, such as the Halbtax subscription, will be taken into account.

















III. Removal of temporary BahnCard from traveler profile

Administration The setting is automatic and cannot be set administratively.

The Deutsche Bahn (DB) no longer issues a "temporary BahnCard". Both through DB interfaces and at travel agencies or DB travel centers, the BahnCard number is now provided directly.

As a result, we have removed the option to store a "temporary BahnCard" in the profile.

IV. Limitation to one traveller per booking

Administration To use this function, please get in touch with your onesto contact.

Until now, it was possible to add additional travellers to a train booking through the profile selection.

With this development, this option can now be turned off, so that no additional travellers can be added to train bookings.

This option is effective for all integrated train interfaces (DB partner interface (PST), ÖBB, benerail, trainline, Česke drahy), but not for DB bahn.business, as additional travellers are added directly on the DB website.

















V. Adding additional travellers without profile selection



Depending on the settings and provider, it is possible to book for multiple travellers at once in the train section.

Now, it is also possible to book for additional travellers who do not have an onesto profile or for whom no booking authorization exists.



When several people are involved in a transaction, billing is always carried out via the person for whom the transaction was created.


















VI. DB Partner Interface (PST) and ÖBB: Seat reservation only (1/2)

Administration The setting is automatic and cannot be set administratively.

With this release, we simplify the booking of seat reservations without a ticket and offer this option directly on the homepage.



Currently, Deutsche Bahn offers seat reservations without a ticket only for one direction of travel.

If a seat reservation is to be made for both the outbound and return journey, it must be booked separately for each direction.

First, book the seat reservation for the outbound journey, and after completion (which is also possible within the same onesto trip), book the reservation for the return journey.


















VI. DB Partner Interface (PST) and ÖBB: Seat reservation only (2/2)

This feature is only active when using the DB partner interface (PST) or ÖBB, and is not offered by other providers or in a combined query of different providers.


















I. Kyte – new airline: Jet2

The 'Kyte' interface, after last year's introduction with Ryanair, will now be expanded in the next step to include another low-cost airline: Jet2.



Jet2 is a British low-cost airline that serves the airports of Berlin and Cologne in Germany. In Austria, it operates flights to Vienna, Salzburg, and Innsbruck, and in Switzerland, it flies to Geneva.

















II. Price limit for seat booking - Setting to travel policy group

We have expanded this feature so that now, price limits can also be managed at the Travel Policy Group level.

















I. CRC - Cost coverage documents available in onesto

CRC has introduced a new feature that allows cost coverage documents to be stored directly in the onesto travel process, making them available to the traveller during the trip, for example, through the 'onesto2go' app.

Below is the wording from CRC regarding this new feature:

Cost coverage documents now directly available in onesto

We are constantly developing our features and would like to inform you today that there is a new update in connection with the use of CRC through onesto.

Central billing via AirPlus is one of the most important services we offer. The handling of cost coverage plays a significant role in this process.

We are now able to provide the cost coverage document, which we communicate to the hotel, directly in onesto for you. Of course, it is still possible to send the document via email to the email address stored in the booking.

With this new feature, the additional email can be omitted, and the traveller will receive the cost coverage document as a PDF along with their travel plan, which can also be accessed through their travel plan.

II. HRS Payment Process - Transfer of email address

When using the HRS billing process (e.g., HRS Invisible Pay), it can now be specified whether the notification from HRS should be sent to the booker, traveller, or a fixed central email address.

This allows, for example, cost coverage documents to be sent to the appropriate recipient.

















III. Hotel blacklist by hotel chains

In addition to the previous options (filtering by specific hotel name or individual hotel ID of the used hotel provider), the chain name can now also be specified, so that each individual property of the chain does not have to be added to the blacklist separately.

This significantly simplifies the maintenance of unwanted hotels.


















I. Display of the Sixt Ride vehicle category

In addition to the well-known sorting by car rental categories, such as Compact, Upper Mid-Range, etc., the Sixt Ride-specific categories, such as Ride, Ride XL, are now also displayed.



















II. Sixt online check-In for corporate customers

In order to ensure the usability of the Sixt Online Check-In, we are integrating a link to Sixt.

The link will be displayed in the booking overview as well as on the PDF travel itinerary.



With the Sixt Online Check-In, travellers can save their driver's license information and thus reduce waiting time and rental formalities at the counter.

















III. Rental Car – custom traffic light color



With this release, it is now possible to configure the traffic light colour for vehicles independently of the vehicle category, based on the provider.

As shown in the example below, electric vehicles can generally be displayed with a green traffic light, even if the associated vehicle category would normally have a different colour assigned.
